

## **Exhibition Facts For the Inquiring Artist**

### **Artist Criteria**

- Must be a local artist living in Missouri or just over the Kansas border
- Maintains a website, Blog or other social media site of work
- Artist resume outlining education, experience, and past shows

### **Requirements for Submissions to Exhibit**

- Along with an artist statement, short biography, and artist resume, the artist must submit at least 8-10 pieces of artwork to fill the front half of the gallery space.
- Submissions can be sent to the gallery director via e-mail. Dropping by and dropping off artwork is not accepted; especially if the artist did not call ahead of time.
- If accepted, the exhibition will be coordinated between the artist and gallery director. An artist/gallery agreement will be signed when the artwork is dropped off. The agreement will list each artwork by title, medium, description, and price. This goes much smoother if the artist has an inventory list ready to go.
- Artwork is sold as consignment. 70% of a sale is received by the artist, 30% is retained by the gallery.
- The gallery will host an opening reception for the artist at the start of their show; although, if the artist does not want to enthusiastically participate in a reception, then the gallery will forgo the reception. We will provide water. The artist is more than welcome to provide additional beverages and food.
- The artist is encouraged to enthusiastically market their exhibition. Friends, family, and collectors need to be contacted and reminded about the event.
